The students of TKM College of Engineering initiated LOVE LOCKS – a hair donation campaign with around 20 keen participants with the help of volunteers to spread smiles on the faces of children and women.

Aardra was a blood stem cell donation awareness and donor campaign conducted in association with THE DATRI FOUNDATION. Our main mission was to promote awareness about the importance and vast possibilities of stem cell donation in cancer treatment. The inspiration of this venture was the story of one of our alumni.

Aardra was started in the year of 2015 as part of RITHU'15 intercollegiate cultural fest of TKM College of Engineering. The program was inaugurated by DR.B.IQBAL (Neurosurgeon, Ex-Chancellor, Kerala University). The event was attended by Mr. Aby Sam, the donor drive coordinator of DATRI FOUNDATION and the first stem cell donor from

Kerala. A total of about 4232 people were registered in this campaign. Due to its success, Aardra was continued in the past 4 years, and thousands of people were ready to be a stem cell donor. Till now 4 of the registries were blessed to donate their stem cells to the leukaemia and thalassemia major patients. This shows the success of this great initiative put forward by TKMCEIANS.
